- For all-day workshops, a lunch break is scheduled. You are welcome to bring a bag lunch or dine at one of the nearby restaurants.
- All classes are held at Wisconsin Center for Book and Paper Arts, 811 Williamson St., Madison, unless otherwise noted.
- REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS ONE WEEK PRIOR TO WORKSHOP.
- Full refund is given if cancellation is received at least one week in advance. One-half refund is given if cancellation is received three days prior to workshop, and no refund is given if less than three days.
- Maximum enrollment is 10 students unless otherwise specified. WCBPA reserves the right to cancel workshops due to low enrollment. You will be notified if a workshop is cancelled.
- Your payment secures reservation for the workshop(s). You will not be sent a confirmation notice.
